




FOR resurrection

During this time of year people like to tell each other scary stories and dress up like monsters; zombies are one of the most popular monsters. Luckily, zombies aren't real but we as Catholics do believe in the dead coming back to life. In fact we speak about this belief whenever we say the Nicene Creed. In the Nicene Creed we state, "...and I look forward to the **resurrection** of the dead." This is because we believe that our souls and bodies will be joined with Christ in heaven we call this **resurrection**. We also talk about how Jesus came back from the dead on the third day in the Nicene Creed! Many scary stories involve skeletons or haunted objects, we know this to be make believe. However, as Catholics we do hold special reverence for the objects and the bodies of the Saints. We call these things **relics** and it is known that through these objects many miracles have occurred. The Church classifies these **relics** into 3 groups, First class, Second class, and Third class. The First Class items are those from Christ's life or the remains of a Saint. Second class items are items used or worn by a Saint. Third class items are any items that have been touched by a First or Second class **relic!**
